Architectural Review Committee Standard SECURITY DOORS and SCREEN DOORS

Adopted: June 21, 2012

A "Secondary Door" is defined as the door outside (or most exterior to) the main residence door. This Standard applies to "screen doors" or "security doors."

A secondary door constructed of <u>all</u> glass or constructed predominantly with other clear material is not permitted.

Secondary door design may be at the homeowner's discretion, but must be designed within harmony with the residential theme.

The color of the secondary door may match either the stucco, the trim, gate, side fence, garage door, or the front door itself. Secondary doors may also be white.

As with all other improvements, a Residence Improvement Application (RIA) must be submitted, with color samples, at least 30 days before start date of installation.
